



What we do:

Old Dog Haven provides a loving, safe home for dogs abandoned in their senior years (8 and up). Some of these dogs are prepared for adoption. Most stay with us for the rest of their lives. We also assist owners in placing senior dogs they cannot care for.

How we do it:

We care for between 170 and 200 dogs thanks to donations and devoted volunteers and supportive local veterinarians. Our wonderful group of foster homes keep these dogs happy and comfortable for a few weeks to a few years, with all medical care provided by ODH. We take dogs primarily from shelters in western Washington - a shelter is a particularly scary place for an older dog. We also take dogs from some owners who must give up their pet; many are left behind when the owner dies or goes into a care facility.

Where the dogs are:

We are not a shelter -- all dogs in our care live in a home with a family. Our foster homes are all over western Washington, most in the Puget Sound area but reaching from Blaine down to Vancouver, Kitsap and Olympic Peninsulas, Vashon and Whidbey Islands. We always need additional foster homes - ask for details.
